Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foundations Sound Cards and Letter Boards • Playing Alphabet Bingo • Repetition of ABC Chart with some pictures/visuals
Comprehension	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accountable talk/turn and talk • Using reading websites such as Starfall.com and talking about the main idea of the story • Small guided reading groups
Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make “Instead of ___, use ___” chart. Use this chart to show synonyms of words • Frontload vocabulary before reading a text • Show visuals to explain a vocabulary word
Fluency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shared reading text for one week • Sight Word Flash Cards • Choral Reading
Phonemic Awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Playing Rhyming Bingo and other games • Tapping out words (C-A-T) and saying as a whole • Clapping out syllables • Word Sorts in large pocket chart

Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Word Work groups – blends, vowels, vowel patterns • Shared Writing • Word Families
Comprehension	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Retelling Hand • Book Reports • Retelling Rope • Picture Walks • Character studies • Emotions • Drawing with detail • Reading response • Partner talk
Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pictures • Picture dictionaries • Word Walls • Use higher level vocabulary • Charts with definitions
Fluency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tally chart on post-it • Familiar stories (poems, songs, etc.) • Picture walks
Phonemic Awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Chunking • Word Families • Ending sounds (-ed, -ing, -s) • Breaking down each syllable • Stretching words

Comprehension	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Oral discussion• Retell each page 1 at a time• Stop and jot
Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Frontloading• Visual representations• Context clues
Fluency	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Repeated reading• Choral reading• Shared Reading/Read Alouds
Phonemic Awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Rhyming• Singing/pointing to the words on the page• Listening center• Syllable tapping

Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Word families• Picture/letter sound• Syllable work
Comprehension	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Retell using “somebody wanted but so...”• Box and bullets• Going back and finding evidence from text
Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Substitute words in sentences that make sense• Vocabulary intensity chart• Prefix and suffix work
Fluency	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shares/Choral Read• Growing sentences• Timed Sight Words
Phonemic Awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sounding out• Chunking• Covering parts of words

Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sounding out • Word families
Comprehension	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Connections to book – text to text and text to self • Reread – monitor for sense • Questions on chart • Prompts • Box/bullets – share text main ideas and details
Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 3x3 index cards for Science and Social Studies • Teach prefix and suffix • Base word parts • Roots • Synonyms
Fluency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shared poems, speeches, songs • Rhymes • Readers Theater
Phonemic Awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Stretch out words • Say sounds • Take apart words in authentic text

Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Practice Sight Words • Word Families
Comprehension	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visualize in your mind through a mental picture • Ask questions before, during, and after • Make connections: text to self, text to text, text to world • Making inference • Determining importance • Activate schema • Synthesize
Vocabulary	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Non-Fiction books: using glossary, word banks, look at illustrations, look at the font • Post-it vocab words while reading • Create mental images • Make connections to the words • Think about synonyms and antonyms • Context clues
Fluency	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use punctuation clues • Read out loud: practice using your voice, make it sound like talking • Repeated reading: read it again – make it sound like talking, until you understand it
Phonemic Awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Articulation of sight words while reading • Sound discrimination
